

Eligibility:

You may be eligible to join ElderServe MAP (HMO D-SNP) if you:

- Are enrolled in Medicare and Medicaid;
- Are 18 years of age or older at the time of enrollment;
- Live in the counties of Bronx, New York (Manhattan), Queens, Kings (Brooklyn), Richmond (Staten Island), Nassau or Westchester;
- Are entitled to full Medicaid coverage;
- Are eligible for nursing home level of care at the time of enrollment;
- Are capable, at the time of enrollment, of returning to or remaining in your home and community without jeopardy to your health and safety, based on criteria provided by NYSDOH;
- Require at least one of the following:
 - Community Based Long Term Care services for more than 120 days from the date of enrollment;
 - Nursing services in the home;
 - Therapies in the home;
 - Home health aide services;
 - Personal care services in the home;
 - Adult day health care;
 - Private duty nursing;
 - Consumer Directed Personal Assistance Services;
 - Require care management and home care or day care services for 120 continuous days or longer and the following minimum need:
 - at least limited assistance with physical maneuvering with more than two activities of daily living (ADLs); or
 - individuals with a Dementia or Alzheimer's diagnosis, assessed as needing at least supervision with more than one ADL


